Rules Corner



Question: Your putt goes past the hole a few inches close enough for a tap in. Are you allowed to reach across the hole and tap it in rather than walk around to the ball and use the regular putting stroke?

Answer: Yes, you are allowed as long as you tap the ball, not scrape or drag it into the hole.

Question: Your ball is resting in a position that is partly on and partly off the putting green. Is your ball considered to be on the putting green?

Answer: Yes. If part of the ball is in both the general area and one of the four specific areas of the course, it is treated as lying in that specific area of the course. Rule 2.2C

The four specific areas of the course are the Teeing Area and Putting Green of the hole being played, as well as all Penalty Areas and Bunkers on the course. All the rest of the course is considered the General Area (which includes the fairway, rough, fringe of green, waste areas and any other parts of the course not defined as Penalty Areas or bunkers).
