Rules Corner



Question: Your rangefinder has the slope feature. Can you use the feature during the sweeps play on Tuesdays?

Answer: No, you cannot use the slope feature during any TPWGC events. The feature has to be turned off or you will incur a two stroke penalty. Second breach of the rule will be disqualification. Rule 4.3.

Question: What happens if you hit a wrong ball?

Answer: Rule 6.3c. In stroke play, the player gets the general penalty (two penalty strokes) and must correct the mistake by continuing play with the original ball by playing it as it lies or taking relief under the Rules.

If the player does not correct the mistake before making a stroke to begin another hole or, for the final hole of the round, before returning their scorecard, the player is disqualified.

In *match play* the player gets the general penalty (loss of hole).

A wrong ball is any other player's ball, a stray ball that was left on the course, or your own ball if it was lying out of bounds, or was found after the 3 minute search period expired.
