Rules Corner



Question: When can you switch your golf ball?

Answer: You can switch balls between holes. You also can substitute a ball during play of a hole if you are taking relief (free or penalty), or if the ball is cut or cracked and the damage happened during play of that hole. Rule4.2

Question: What do you do if a player in her golf cart accidentally drives over your ball and the ball is now plugged?

Confront her, say some choice words and then tell her to pay more attention? **NO!**

Drive over her ball? NO!

Dig out your ball, give yourself a nice fluffy, even lie, and proceed? **NO!**

Answer: You get to replace the ball at the nearest point similar to the original lie up to one club length without penalty, no nearer the hole, in the same part of the golf course. You may clean the ball. Rule 9.6 and 14.2d.
