Rules Corner



PROVISIONAL BALL, Part 1:

Playing a provisional ball is an option to speed up play when you believe your ball is Lost or Out of Bounds. Here are the steps in playing a provisional ball:

1. Declare clearly you are playing a "Provisional ball" by stating you are playing a Provisional Ball. You can't just say "I'll play another ball."

It must be clear you are announcing a Provisional Ball.

2. Your Provisional Ball stays a Provisional Ball until one of three things happen:

a. You've searched for 3 minutes and not found the original. At that point your original is a Lost Ball, **even if you find it after 3 minutes.**

b. You found and identified your original ball before the 3-minute time has passed, at which point the Provisional Ball must be abandoned.

c. You played your Provisional Ball at a point that is closer to the hole than where your original ball is estimated to be.

3. You may continue to play the Provisional Ball without losing its status as a Provisional Ball so long as it is played from a spot that's the same distance or farther from the hole than where your original ball is estimated to be.
