Rules Corner



During the Club Championship there were a few issues that we would like to bring to your attention.

1. The Notice to Players sheet stated that the local rule for Lost and Out-of-Bounds would not be followed – that the stroke and distance rule would be in effect. (Rule 1.2). This is true for the Ace of Aces tournament, too. Not playing the rule is a serious breach and results in disqualification. (Rule 1.3)

2. Hole score disagreements: After completion of a hole and before the next tee shot, your group should confirm scores for each player so that if there are any disagreements, your memory is still fresh as to the number of strokes made. If for some reason, the disagreement is found at the end of the round, the matter should be brought to the tournament committee before leaving the course. Signing a scorecard that is lower than the actual score, results in disqualification. (Rule 3.3).

3. Code of Conduct: Members are reminded that the game of golf is centered around integrity and proper etiquette. (Rule 1.2a,b). Please review the Code of Conduct on the club's website.
