RULES CORNER



Posting Your Scores from the Rules Of Handicapping.

When should we post?

A player should submit their score ASAP on the day of play, after completion of their round, and before midnight.

Why that day? Their Handicap Index won't be updated in time for the next day (see Rule 5.4) and the score won't be included in the daily playing conditions calculation (PCC). (see Rule 5.6).

What should we post? All rounds played that meet the following criteria, includes, Stroke, Match, Home and Away, and Casual plays:
* In an organized comp or general plays over at least the minimum number of holes required. 9-holes for a 9-hole course or 10-18 holes for 18-hole score.

*In the company of at least 1 other person, who may act as a marker.

* On a course with a current Course and Slope Rating, where length and difficulty is maintained at a consistent level.

*On a golf course during its active season.

POST HOLE-BY-HOLE SCORES or 9 or 18 hole **adjusted** gross scores – net double bogey.
